### **BE FREE RETREAT GOALS**

To cultivate and prepare an environment in which attendees can experience and receive divine revelation

For each person in attendance to encounter the extravagant love of the Father, the amazing grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the intimate friendship of the Holy Spirit through the power of Jesus

To usher in freedom in Christ, who overcame the devil and set us free from sin and bondage so we can love others, bear fruit, take our stand against the devil, and enjoy the presence of God every day of our lives

### **TEAM COLORS**

*Retreat teams are identified by specific colors. Please see the descriptions below to learn about the significance of each one.*

#### **Intercessor Team: White**

This team wears white, a sign of purity, victory, and righteousness through Christ. They lead the battle and provide a prayer covering over the room. They keep the enemy at bay and act as watchmen as well as worshipers and builders, creating an atmosphere in which the power of God can be released. Intercessors focus on the big picture: Freedom. They rely on the Holy Spirit to point them toward specific areas or groups of people or even other teams who may need intercession (things like fatigue, fear, or focus), and they discern where and how to focus their prayers.

#### **Prayer Team: Red**

This team wears red, which represents the blood of Jesus—and there is power in the blood! Their role is to listen to the Holy Spirit, love people to wholeness, and to be bold in the face of the enemy. The Prayer Team focuses on “the one.” Each person who comes forward to receive prayer is the one to whom God wants to extend freedom and healing, and this team in turn becomes tangible hands, feet, and voices for the message of victory.

**Host Team: Light Blue**

The Host Team ministers to participants and maintains order and flow in the auditorium. They are there to support the ministry happening on the line and assist participants.

**Events Team: Navy Blue**

The Events team ministers to participants by maintaining order outside of the auditorium. They are there to create a warm, welcoming, and distraction-free environment, so that participants can experience freedom.

**Captain Team: Neon**

This team wears neon, a color that simply signifies support to the retreat teams. Their role is to help the Prayer Team and provide additional prayer covering for participants as well as Retreat team members. If questions arise, Captains can help facilitate answers and are available to provide extra help during prayer times.

## **SECTION 1 PREPARE**

## **ENCOURAGED & EQUIPPED** *How to prepare for your role in the Retreat*

### **Stay Humble.**

A humble heart and a sincere desire to see others experience the freedom in Christ that you have personally experienced are essential when it comes to being an effective member of the BE FREE Retreat team.

### **Commit to unity.**

It takes a big team composed of many smaller teams to make this Retreat a success. Just as each team has a responsibility, the men and women serving on those teams have specific responsibilities as well. Respect them and look for ways to help and encourage your brothers and sisters. Think of yourself as a soldier in a battle. As you war against the enemy, you must be **in unity**, or he will be able to penetrate and resist our efforts to bring people to freedom.

“Therefore I, a prisoner for serving the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of your calling, for you have been called by God. Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other’s faults because of your love. Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace.” Ephesians 4:1-3

*Remember: This is not about you; it is about our King, Jesus, and His heart to bring freedom to those that He loves so much. You are helping extend His kingdom.*

### **Make preparation a priority.**

Take time to prepare your heart for what the Lord wants to do in and through you. Study the Word and find out where your strength comes from. Focus on faith and obedience in your daily activities and be intentional about seeking Him and having a heart of thankfulness. Be genuine with God and give Him access to your struggles and desires. Turn to Him when you sin, and choose to have a forgiving heart. Being intentional with your relationship with the Lord will help you come to the Retreat prepared to minister with a heart that is open and sensitive to the Holy Spirit who will use you to do great things!

## **FAITH IN ACTION**

### *Practical ways to prepare*

#### **Fasting**

Fasting helps change your focus and is useful in preparing yourself for ministry, especially when engaging in spiritual warfare. You can fast in a variety of ways (talk to your team leader if you would like more information) but remember the most important part of fasting does not involve what you take away, but

what you add regarding time spent with the Lord. Ask Him what needs to be done in your heart as you fast.

(Tip: Fast before, not at the Retreat—it is good to go into battle strengthened.)

“Is it a fast that I have chosen, a day for a man to afflict his soul? Is it to bow down his head like a bulrush, and to spread out sackcloth and ashes? Would you call this a fast, and an acceptable day to the LORD? “Is this not the fast that I have chosen: To loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, to let the oppressed go free, and that you break every yoke?” (Isaiah 58)

### **Prayer**

Prayer readies your heart for battle and helps you hear and know God’s voice. In 1 Thessalonians 5:17, the Bible says to “pray without ceasing.” Live a lifestyle of prayer. Never underestimate the power of God working through heartfelt prayers; they release the power of God and change reality.

“The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.” James 5:16

### **The Word**

The Word is the Sword of the Spirit, and it is instrumental in seeing the works of darkness destroyed. Just as food nourishes your body, the Word nourishes your soul. The Word is a major warfare weapon. As you study, ask the Lord to write the scriptures on your heart and get ready to be amazed by the way God uses those very scriptures to serve participants.

John 8:32 says that the truth will set us free. The Holy Spirit actually ignites the truth that we’ve poured into ourselves, and He uses it to cut through the lies and deception that have people bound. The powers of darkness recognize the eternal Word of God. When Jesus was tempted by satan, He said three times, “It is written, it is written, it is written.”

“It is the same with my word. I send it out, and it always produces fruit. It will accomplish all I want it to, and it will prosper everywhere I send it.” Isaiah 55:11

“For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.” Hebrews 4:12

“All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.” 2 Timothy 3:16-17

## **Worship**

When all else fails and your will or desire are gone, worship is the way back into life abundant. He is worthy of praise, so even when you do not feel like praising, choosing to glorify Him changes things in your heart and mind. Worship not only brings the presence of God into our lives, but it also establishes His dominion in us. Praise and worship unlock doors and break down walls in ways that we cannot see; worship is warfare.

“Let everything that has breath praise the Lord.” Psalm 150:6

“Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edged sword in their hand, to execute vengeance.” Psalm 149:6-7

## **SECTION 2 EXECUTE**

## Intercessor Strategy

Mission: The goal of the Intercessor Team at the BE FREE Retreat is to create an open Heaven and shut out the enemy in a role of spiritual support for both the Host and Prayer Teams as they minister to participants.

As an intercessor it is an incredible honor to be able to support this Freedom Ministry. Our goal is to provide this support with an attitude of grace and honor to all we encounter. We provide the spiritual covering that makes the way smooth for freedom and deliverance to find those long held by the enemy. We pray because someone once prayed for us as we received ministry at a BE FREE Retreat.

### Two Ways to Intercede

- Worshippers – Create an open Heaven.
- Warriors – Bind the enemy's attempts to oppose freedom.

### The Role of the Holy Spirit

Over the course of the Retreat, you may find yourself interceding as a warrior and as a worshipper at different times throughout the weekend. Follow the Holy Spirit's promptings. Our goal is that at any given moment some intercessors will be confronting the enemy and others will be in communion with God. Listen for His direction.

Whether you find yourself praying as a worshipper or as a warrior, let the Word be your guide. This manual is full of Scripture. Pray through verses knowing that as you speak the Word in prayer God assures us that "it will not return void".

### Worship Intercessors

Praise and Honor (or Bless) the Lord

#### Goal

Praise God in advance for the life change that will take place through the course of the weekend. Recognize all He means and all He is to us. Pray that everyone in attendance will experience the reality that Jesus opened up heaven



for us through His blood and that His grace is capable of wiping away all of the issues of our past! Worship and connect with the Lord and be conduits of His presence. Focus on His attributes. Enthroned Him with praise. This is the heart of worship.

True worship paves the way for His glory. In the Bible, where there was true Spirit worship, the manifest presence of God came into that place.

When Solomon finished praying, fire came down from heaven and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices, and the glory of the Lord filled the temple. The priests could not enter the temple of the Lord because the glory of the Lord filled it. When all the Israelites saw the fire coming down and the glory of the Lord above the temple, they knelt on the pavement with their faces to the ground, and they worshipped and gave thanks to the Lord saying, "He is good; his love endures forever." 2 Chronicles 7:1-3

Moses and Aaron went from the assembly to the entrance to the tent of meeting and fell facedown, and the glory of the Lord appeared to them. Numbers 20:6

It is always a good idea when worshipping to pray through scriptures. Refer to the worship scriptures in the manual as you intercede as a worshipper.

## **Warfare Intercessors**

Pray for Prayer Team members and BE FREE Retreat participants

### **Goal**

Pray in faith, boldness, and confidence. Warfare Intercessors pray strongly with a military might. They battle the strongholds and principalities. They are fighters.

Prayer is not just conversation with God – it is also confrontation with the enemy. God designed prayer to be strategic and to have a purpose. God wants our prayer to have objective. Spiritual warfare prayer is powerful and exciting. The ultimate goal of spiritual warfare is for souls to be saved and the glory of the Lord to fill the earth.

**Three mighty weapons of authority we use in warfare prayer are the name of Jesus, the blood of Jesus and the Word of God.**

**The name of Jesus** has power. It is above every other name. It's above cancer, diabetes, depression, and every evil force in the world.

**The blood of Jesus** that was shed on the cross was the ultimate defeat for the enemy. When in warfare we must remember that His blood allows us to fight from a position of victory! Most of the Armor of God is defensive (it protects us).

**The word or God** (or sword of the spirit) is the offensive weapon in the armor of God and the one we need on hand whenever we go into warfare. Warfare prayer involves knowing the word, confessing the word, and using the word just as Jesus did when He was confronted.

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. Therefore, put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. Ephesians 6:10-13

## **To Prepare**

### **1. Consistency in Devotion – Prayer/ Worship/ Word**

Do everything you can to immerse yourself in the word, in worship music, and in prayer. Read confessions over yourself and over all the team and participants.

Consistency is the key when it comes to prayer for protection and deliverance. We must “dwell” in the secret place to “abide” under the Almighty's protective shadow.

He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. (Psalm 91:1, NKJV)

The word dwell in this verse means to remain or abide, to dwell or inhabit. The point is that it must be a lifestyle, not just a once in a while activity. We must make the secret place our habitation or “dwelling” place. The word “abide” in this verse means among other things “to spend the night.” You could read it like this: “He that dwells in the secret place of the Most High will spend the night in the shadow of the Almighty.” Consistency is the key.

## 2. Simple devotion

Devotion to Jesus is our springboard. We must get really simple in our devotion to him. This is the springboard for everything we do.

But I am afraid that, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, your minds will be led astray from the simplicity and purity of devotion to Christ. (2 Corinthians 11:3, NASB)

We wait in hope for the LORD; he is our help and our shield. (Psalm 33:20)

My soul thirsts for God, for the living God.  
When can I go and meet with God? (Psalm 42:2)

Wait and thirst are the same Hebrew word (*chakah*) that means “adhere to” or “long for”. David longed for God’s company.  
(*Dutch Sheets, Intercessory Prayer, pg. 143*)

Remember that it’s our declaration of surrender to Him and dependence on Him that becomes our source for everything we do.

## 3. Remember, We are in a war!

We are in a real war.  
(2 Corinthians 10:4; 1 Timothy 1:18)

We are soldiers in this war.  
(Psalms 110:2-3; 2 Timothy 2:3-4)

We are to wrestle against all levels of the kingdom of darkness.  
(Ephesians 6:12)

We are to resist the devil (demons in most cases) and he will flee from us. (James 4:7; 1 Peter 5:9)

We are to tread on satan and his demons – exercise authority. (Luke 10:19; Romans 16:20)

We are to cast out demons. (Mark 16:17)  
We have authority to bind (forbid) and loose (permit) when dealing with the agents and gates of hell. (Matthew 16:19)

We have powerful weapons designed to overcome the kingdom of darkness. (2 Corinthians 10:4; Ephesians 6:10-20)

#### **Important Information**

##### **Team Check-In and Team Worship**

Check-in, lanyards, and Retreat Team shirt pick-up will be available before Team Worship – all Freedom Team members must be registered to check-in and receive their Freedom Retreat Team t-shirt. Please refer to your specific schedule for time and location.

##### **Dress for the Retreat**

Team t-shirt and nice, comfortable blue jeans. No torn jeans or shorts. Comfortable shoes.

You may wear a long-sleeve t-shirt *under* your Team shirt if you get cold easily, but please do not wear a jacket over your shirt.

##### **Meals**

Dinner will be provided to the BE FREE Retreat Team only on Friday night. Breakfast and lunch will be served to Freedom Team members and participants on Saturday.

##### **Personal Belongings**

It is recommended to bring only necessary personal items into the BE FREE Retreat. Please secure any valuables out of sight in your car.

##### **Reserved Seats**

We ask that leaders do not reserve seats for participants. Our heart is for all of the participants to feel welcome and valued, and we do not want the wrong

# **SECTION 3 RESOURCES**

# **FREEDOM Scriptures We are**

## **DISTRIBUTERS OF GRACE!**

The BE FREE Retreat Teams are go-betweens who distribute the salvation, the peace, the grace, the life, and the abundance of God. We come to as kings and priests to enforce what our King, Savior, and Lord Jesus accomplished for everyone by giving His life for us on the cross. We destroy everything that comes against the knowledge of Jesus Christ and pull up the root cause of every problem since the beginning of time: Shame and Condemnation.

## **Foundational Scriptures for FREEDOM**

Romans 1:16-17 – For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God (the Good News of the CROSS is the POWER) to salvation (not only eternal salvation, but wholeness, health, peace of mind, prosperity, DELIVERANCE) for everyone who believes (not works!), for the Jew first and also for the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from FAITH TO FAITH; as it is written, “The just shall live by FAITH.”

Romans 5:17 - If, by the trespass of the one man, death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive God’s abundant provision of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ.

2 Corinthians 5:21 - He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the RIGHTEOUSNESS OF GOD in Him.

## **NEW COVENANT**

### **CANCELED DEBT, THE MIND, SEATED, PEACE, REST**

Isaiah 53:12 – For He bore the sin of many, and MADE INTERCESSION for the transgressors.

Ephesians 1:20-22 – God seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, FAR ABOVE ALL PRINCIPALITY AND POWER AND MIGHT AND DOMINION, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church.

Isaiah 26:3 – You will keep him in perfect peace, WHOSE MIND IS STAYED ON YOU, because he trusts in You.

1 Peter 2:13 - Therefore, prepare your minds for action, keep sober in spirit, **FIX YOUR HOPE COMPLETELY ON THE GRACE** to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

### **GRACE, HEIRS**

Romans 5:8 – But God **DEMONSTRATES HIS OWN LOVE** toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Galatians 3:29: If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham’s seed, and **HEIRS ACCORDING TO THE PROMISE.**

2 Corinthians 3:18 - We all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, **ARE BEING TRANSFORMED INTO THE SAME IMAGE FROM GLORY TO GLORY**, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

Romans 4:13 – Abraham and his offspring received the promise that he would be **HEIR OF THE WORLD** through the righteousness that comes by faith.

### **ABBA**

Galatians 4:6 - Because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, “**ABBA, FATHER!**”

Romans 8:15 – For you did not receive a spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the **SPIRIT OF SONSHIP** by which we cry out Abba Father.

Matthew 6:31–32 - Jesus said, “Therefore, do not worry, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’... For your **HEAVENLY FATHER (Abba)** knows that you need all these things.”

John 17:26- Jesus said, “And I have declared to them **YOUR NAME (ABBA)**, and will declare it, that the love with which You loved Me may be in them, and I in them.”

John 17:11 - Now I am no longer in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to You. Holy Father (Daddy), **KEEP (PROTECT) THROUGH YOUR NAME** those whom You have given Me, that they may be one as We are.



## **AUTHORITY**

Ephesians 1:17-19: "I pray also that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know...HIS INCOMPARABLY GREAT POWER FOR US WHO BELIEVE. That power is like the working of His mighty strength."

Romans 8:11 - "The Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead DWELLS IN YOU."

John 14:12 – "Anyone who has faith in Me will do what I have been doing. He will do EVEN GREATER THINGS than these, because I am going to the Father."

Acts 3:4-7 – "LOOK AT US!" .... In the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene-walk!" And seizing him by the right hand, he raised him up; and immediately his feet and his ankles were strengthened.

John 14:13-14 - I will do whatever you ask IN MY NAME, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father. You may ask Me for anything in My name, and I will do it.

Romans 8:38-39 – For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

1 John 4:4 – GREATER IS HE THAT IS IN ME than he that is in the world.

## **Worship Scriptures**

### **The Name of the Lord**

God said to Moses, "I AM who I AM. (Exodus 3:14)

For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on His shoulders. and He will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6)

Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me will never go hungry, and he who believes in Me will never be thirsty." (John 6:35)

"I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6) "I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved." (John 10:9)

"I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, "who is, and who was, and who is to come, the Almighty." (Revelation 1:8)

My Righteousness, "Jehovah Tsidkenu." - Jeremiah 23:6: In His days Judah will be saved and Israel will live in safety. This is the name by which He will be called: The LORD Our Righteousness.

The Sanctifier, "Jehovah M-kaddesh." - Leviticus 20:7-8: "Consecrate yourselves and be holy, because I am the LORD your God. Keep my decrees and follow them. I am the LORD, who makes you holy."

My Healer, "Jehovah Rapha." - Exodus 15:26: He said, "If you listen carefully to the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in his eyes, if you pay attention to his commands and keep all his decrees, I will not bring on you any of the diseases I brought on the Egyptians, for I am the LORD, who heals you."

My Provider, "Jehovah Jireh." - Genesis 22:14: So Abraham called that place The LORD Will Provide. And to this day it is said, "On the mountain of the LORD it will be provided. Because the Lord is your provider, go ahead and tell Him what your needs are and ask Him to provide for you.

My Banner of victory, "Jehovah Nissi." - Exodus 17:15: Moses built an altar and called it The LORD is my Banner. When in battle, the banner was carried by the person at the front of the army. The banner said, "We win!" The Lord goes before into every battle. He leads us in a triumphal procession. Our enemies lose, we win.

My Peace, "Jehovah Shalom." - Judges 6:23-24: But the LORD said to him, "Peace! Do not be afraid. You are not going to die." So Gideon built an altar to the LORD there and called it The LORD is Peace.

My Shepherd, "Jehovah Raah." - Psalm 23:1: The LORD is my shepherd, I shall not be in want.

The Lord who is there, "Jehovah Shammah." - Let them praise the name of the LORD, For His name alone is exalted; His glory is above the earth and heaven. (Psalm 148:13, NKJV)

## **Worship in Heaven, majesty, glory, presence, goodness, praise**

Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence? (Psalm 139:7)

Who is like the LORD our God, the One who sits enthroned on high.  
(Psalm 113:5)

For great is your love, higher than the heavens; your faithfulness reaches to the skies. (Psalm 108:4)

And the LORD said, “I will cause all my goodness to pass in front of you, and I will proclaim my name, the LORD, in your presence. I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion.  
(Exodus 33:19)

And He passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, “The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness.” (Exodus 34:6)

He brought me to the banqueting house, and his banner over me was love.  
(Song of Solomon 2:4, NKJV)

Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever. (Psalm 23:6)

### **Joy**

THE LORD reigns; let the earth rejoice! (Psalm 97:1, NKJV)

Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice! (Philippians 4:4, NKJV)

This is the day the LORD has made; we will rejoice and be glad in it. (Psalm 118:24, NKJV)

Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; Let the sea roar, and all its fullness;  
Let the field be joyful, and all that *is* in it.  
Then all the trees of the woods will rejoice before the LORD. (Ps 96:11-12, NKJV)

“Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready.” (Revelations

19:7, NKJV)

Then the angel said to them, “Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people.” (Luke 2:10, NKJV)

### **Word, Faith, Ask**

So is my word that goes out from my mouth: it will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it. (Isaiah 55:11)

Then the LORD said to me, “You have seen well, for I am watching over My word to perform it.” (Jeremiah 1:12)

For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any doubleedged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. Nothing in all creation is hidden from God’s sight. (Hebrews 4:12-13)

He sent forth his word and healed them; he rescued them from the grave. (Psalm 107:20)

If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you. (John 15:7)

Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven. (Matthew 18:19, NKJV)

If you ask anything in My name, I will do it (John 14:14, NKJV)

You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you. (John 15:16)

### **Warfare Scriptures**

For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, and you have been given fullness in Christ, who is the head over every power and authority. (Col. 2:9-11)

[He is] far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come (Ephesians 1:21)
